Key Responsibilities

- In collaboration with the AP Curriculum, conduct parent workshops

- Enhance staff understanding of the school curriculum.

- In collaboration with the AP Curriculum, professional development on curriculum and pedagogy.
- Assist teachers in creating curriculum-aligned materials, especially for Language Arts.
- Provide resources related to Language Arts instruction and curriculum.
- Contribute to and support instructional decisions based on assessment data.
- Research instructional and curriculum approaches and programmes, staying up to date with current evidence-based practice.
- Support teachers to align teaching with standards, curriculum, and assessments.
- Model differentiated and inclusive instruction, through demonstration of planning and teaching practice
- Support teachers to enhance classroom engagement, motivation and management.
- Use student data to improve teaching and learning.
- Support the analysis of student assessment data.
