As the children become proficient in Literacy and Numeracy the curriculum shifts towards a subject-based, more structured timetable preparing the children for the next step in their journey through school life.



# Developing

In Key Stage 2 we follow the National Curriculum as a general guide, but allow for in-depth study and a rich and varied curriculum. By developing lively minds through learning experiences which are stimulating, challenging and purposeful, our children achieve excellent results. As well as providing a solid foundation in English and Mathematics, specialist teachers develop their skills in Music, French, Latin, Science and Sport. By the end of Year 6, our children are appropriately confident and prepared to meet the challenges ahead in the Senior School.





# Imagining

We aim to enhance the quality of the child's life through a broad range of aesthetic, creative experiences. Children express their ideas, feelings and experiences through the Creative and Performing Arts as individuals, and in collaboration with others. We aim to nurture the child's self-esteem and foster creativity through participation. This enables individual children to develop their potential as they experience the excitement and satisfaction of being actively engaged in their own imagining.





# Challenging

Learning outdoors helps children to develop the ability to encounter and cope with a wide variety of experiences. It requires them to make informed choices and to understand and take responsibility for the consequences. It instils in the children a sense of adventure which, in turn, fuels their imagination. Risk and challenge are provided in our exciting and newly developed outdoor education programme – from challenging activities within the school grounds, to Forest School and adventurous residential trips.
