The Performing Arts Faculty

Staffing

The Faculty currently consists of the Director of Study/Faculty Leader, who is also in charge of Drama/Musical Theatre, a temporary Music/Performing Arts teacher, one Dance/PE teacher, one PE teacher with an additional responsibility within the PE department and four part- time teachers of PE who also teach in other Faculty areas.

KS3

We have recently moved towards an integrated KS3. In Years 7 and 8 pupils study Performing Arts. They receive three lessons a fortnight. This is to be reviewed once we have appointed a successful Music candidate as our curriculum will largely be shaped by their skills and expertise.

Year 9 have separate Music and Drama lessons. They currently receive one per fortnight.

Years 7 and 8 receive three PE lessons a fortnight and two per fortnight in Year 9. Currently, Dance is taught through PE at KS3. This is another curriculum area we will be reviewing in the future.

Extra-Curricular

Extra-curricular is at the heart of what we do at Fairfield. We currently provide a variety of extracurricular opportunities but are looking to expand on these in the future. Currently, we offer:

- An annual school musical
- Several Drama clubs
- A Musical Theatre club
- A vocal group
- A Dance club
- Peripatetic music lessons
- Fairfield's Got Talent
- Termly showcases
- Mini performances that support other events in school i.e. autism awareness day, mental health awareness week etc.
- Several sporting clubs that change throughout the year
- Regular theatre trips

We also regularly train for, and compete in, Tameside PE competitions.

Facilities

Many of our facilities were upgraded in 2015.

We have a Black Box style Drama Studio and School Hall with stage that are both equipped with lighting and sound equipment. In addition to this, we have a Music classroom and a Music practice room. The Music classroom is equipped with computers installed with Cubase Elements 9 and MuseScore. We also have access to a range of instruments. (There is scope for the successful candidate to upgrade the Music facilities).

In addition to this, we have a brand new Dance Studio with full-length mirrors, wall mounted ballet bars, a sprung floor and lighting/sound equipment.

We have a full sized Sports Hall, which accommodates a full netball court, basketball court, handball court and volleyball court, along with four full-size badminton courts. We also have use of a concrete MUGA, which accommodates two full-sized netball courts and three tennis courts, along with a large field big enough for one full-sized football pitch.
