

Graduate Musician in Residence, September 2024 for one year

This full-time, term-time only post would suit a recent graduate, an undergraduate due to graduate this summer or a professional musician with a strong interest in education. They will join the thriving musical life of the school and work in teaching facilities which are modern and well-appointed. The successful candidate will be an inspirational, energetic and proactive individual with strong keyboard skills and a willingness to get involved in all aspects of the musical life of the school.

Previous experience of teaching is not essential but strong applicants will possess a suitable range of personal qualities and interests. In the absence of previous experience, the successful candidate will be invited to spend some time (paid) at Colfe's in June or July for in-house training.

The workload will be tailored to suit the particular strengths of the appointee but will include some or all of the following:
